2025 BCANY NYS Basketball Hall of Fame

BCANY Membership Campaign for 2024. *Goal of 2000*

BCANY has averaged about 1100 – 1300 over the years. Those numbers dropped to 490 during the pandemic. There was a decent rebound in 2024, with 989 joining. *Michigan and Texas lead the nation with around 5000 member coaches each.*

It would seem that BCANY, this year could reach the 2000 members plateau for the first time in its existence.
