June 2022 DI Men's Basketball Scholastic Recruiting Events

NYSPHSAA and BCANY fought consistently since last June to be able to have comingled June Scholastic Events. We wanted to have the teams from the New York State Public High School Athletic Association, the Catholic High School Athletic Association and the New York State Alliance of Independent Schools play against each other in events. As it still stands now the National Federation of High Schools still says NO. BCANY does not think this makes any sense and it certainly is an exclusive rather than inclusive policy and attitude. In their eyes the NFHS made a compromise by stating that teams from different associations could play games under the same roof, but not against each other.

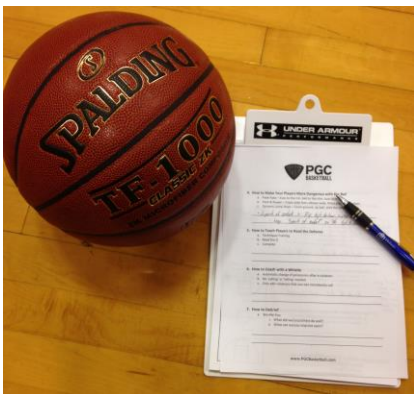
Boys: Dave Archer – HS and College Coach & Founder of BCANY
